Minutes of previous year's AGM	Last year's minutes dated 17 July 24 were approved (nominated by Moira Packer, seconded by Lucy Knight.)
Chairperson's Annual Report	This was approved.
Officers' Reports	<p>There was an update to the Publicity Officer's report from Faye Gibson:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Facebook has been used to advertise the League, but I think we can achieve more. Only Swans and Spires regularly tag activities, more teams doing this would give us more exposure. - I think the website would benefit from a refresh and speedier updates. A more modern look and up-to-date pictures would help attract people. - The role can be as big or small as you want to make it but an improved website and strong social media would help the league. - The charts show that with minimal effort our views and followers have increased massively. We now have over 100 followers. <p>There was no discussion round any of the other papers, and they were approved.</p>
Motions received	<p>1) To have a consistent use of the name 'chairperson' instead of 'chairman' throughout the constitution. Nominated: Lucy Gant (Swans) Seconded: Aimee Anderson (Swans)</p> <p>Passed unanimously</p> <p>2) League to send entry and court fees prior to the season starting. Nominated: Georgie Dixon (Swans) Seconded: Aimee Anderson (Swans)</p> <p>Passed unanimously</p> <p>3) Fixtures should be finalised and communicated at least two weeks before the start of the league. Ideally 3 weeks prior to any league games or tournaments. Nominated: Raiiti Lee (Swans) Seconded: Aimee Anderson (Swans)</p>

	<p>It was noted that this could only happen if both the teams and committee were able to organise and submit entries during the summer holidays rather than wait til September.</p> <p>Agreed: 13 For, 1 Against</p> <p>4) The league to provide umpire mentoring during the summer league for all abilities to ensure continuous development for all levels. Nominated: Raiiti Lee Seconded: Lucy Grant (Both Swans)</p> <p>Kelly thanked Sue and Dan for the great support we'd had for umpire development this year. It was noted that repeating this would be dependent on funding and teams continuing to support with mentors.</p> <p>Agreed : 12 For, 2 Against</p> <p>5) Committee members should meet at least quarterly to discuss league matters. A minimum of two of these meetings should be face to face. Nominated: Raiiti Lee Seconded: Aimee Anderson (Swans)</p> <p>It was noted that the current constitution requires two meetings a year and people's availability often made it hard to schedule face to face meetings.</p> <p>Rejected: 4 For, 9 Against, 1 Abstention</p>
Elections	<p>Secretary: the position was unfilled. This will be taken forward by Kelly outside the meeting.</p> <p>Website & Publicity: Lily Mae Richardson from Spires was nominated by Moira Packer, seconded by Raiiti Lee and voted in unanimously.</p> <p>Membership Secretary: Sherrie Symes of West Harnham was nominated by Alice Judd, seconded by Bronwen Lee and voted in unanimously.</p> <p>All the remaining officers offering to re-stand were voted in unanimously.</p>
